Workshop Foci and Aims



The topical foci of this workshop is on parent-child relationships, peer relationships, religious values, prosocial behavior, and issues of tensions between traditional and contemporary (international) values. This workshop will bring together distinguished senior scholars from the United States, Asia, and Europe focusing on multiple aspects of values, their impact on socialization agents and child and adolescent development, and the methodological issues pertaining to the study of these topics. Participating early career scholars will be afforded the opportunity to learn from the senior scholars, and make connections across countries with their peers. Early career scholars will also have a forum in the form of poster presentations and oral presentations to

present and receive feedback on their ongoing research.

The official language of the meeting is English.

Who can apply?

We will invite 35 to 40 early career scholars from the South-East Asian region who are interested in the study of children and adolescents' social and emotional development. Participants will come predominately from Indonesia, Malaysia, and Singapore (and other Asian countries) to participate in the program.

Early career scholars are defined as those who have completed their post-graduate degree within the prior 10 years. Graduate students in the later stages of Ph.D. study are also eligible to participate. Participants should have an interest in the topic area but may focus their own research on any aspect of lifespan human development.

Financial issues

There will be no registration fee for workshop attendance. Accommodation and meals will be provided. Participants will be provided with a travel allocation based on their locations.
